

Pelican Sound Local Rules

1. Out of Bounds is defined by the inside edge of white stakes or white lines plus homeowner's grass on the following holes Lakes # 1,3,4,5,6,7,8,9; Sound # 1,2,3,4,8,9; River # 2,3,6,7,8,9. White lines or homeowners' grass take precedence over white stakes. In these cases, white stakes are not the boundary – only there to show there is OB in the area. The fencing on Lakes #3 & #7 is also Out of Bounds. Model Local Rule E-5 for alternative to stroke and distance penalty is in effect. From the "point" where the ball is deemed to have crossed out of bounds or is lost, under penalty of 2 strokes, the ball may be dropped from the relief area of that "point" to within 2 club lengths into the hole's fairway, no closer to the hole and no limit on how far back on that line.
2. Penalty Areas are the outside area edge of red stakes or lines (lines take precedence).
3. Red stakes with green tops designate Environmentally Sensitive Areas which are "No Play Zones", no entrance or play from these areas – even to retrieve golf balls.
4. Drop areas are located on all par 3's plus Lakes #3 & #9, Sound #4 & #8, River #9.
5. If a ball lies within 2 club lengths of a sprinkler head which is within 2 club lengths from the edge of the putting green and lies directly on the line of the play between the ball & the hole, the player may take free relief by lifting & dropping at the nearest point where the ball lays, not nearer the hole, and avoids interference from the sprinkler head.
6. All concrete cart paths are considered immovable obstructions. If your stance or swing interferes with the cart path, you may take a free drop one club length, no closer to the hole from the nearest point of relief that avoids the interference.
7. In closely mown areas (fairways only), if your ball lies within one club length of a metal drain cover, your ball is considered in "ground under repair". From the nearest point of relief, you make take a free drop within one club length, no closer to the hole.

Flags are color coded for position on the green:

Red – Front Yellow – Middle Blue – Back

Enter fairway at 90°, stay in fairway, **AVOID DRIVING IN THE ROUGH**,
exit fairway at exit stake.

An acceptable pace of play for 18 Holes is four hours.
